

# 'New interchange to spur demand for properties in i-City'

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The i-City interchange and other future infrastructures will spur demand for properties in i-City, Shah Alam, said I-Berhad executive chairman Tan Sri Lim Kim Hong.

The i-City interchange, which links the Federal Highway to Section 7 Shah Alam, was officially opened yesterday, providing an alternative access to Shah Alam.

The interchange would cater to the expected rise in traffic volume resulting from the transformation of Section 7 from an education and industrial hub into a urban centre-cum-tourism destination, said Lim in a statement.



The impetus for this transformation was partly due to the development of i-City and the opening of

the Shah Alam General Hospital.

The i-City interchange ramp (from Kuala Lumpur) will take mo-

torists directly into i-City while the i-City interchange ramp from Klang will lead to the Central i-City shopping centre.

Lim said the opening of the final phase of the i-City interchange would make it more convenient for tourists to visit Leisure Park@i-City.

"In the long-term, better public transport infrastructure will have a positive impact on the demand for properties in i-City.

To cater to the expected increase in traffic following the opening of the final phase of the i-City interchange, i-City is expediting the completion of its 6,500-bay parking facility by year-end.
